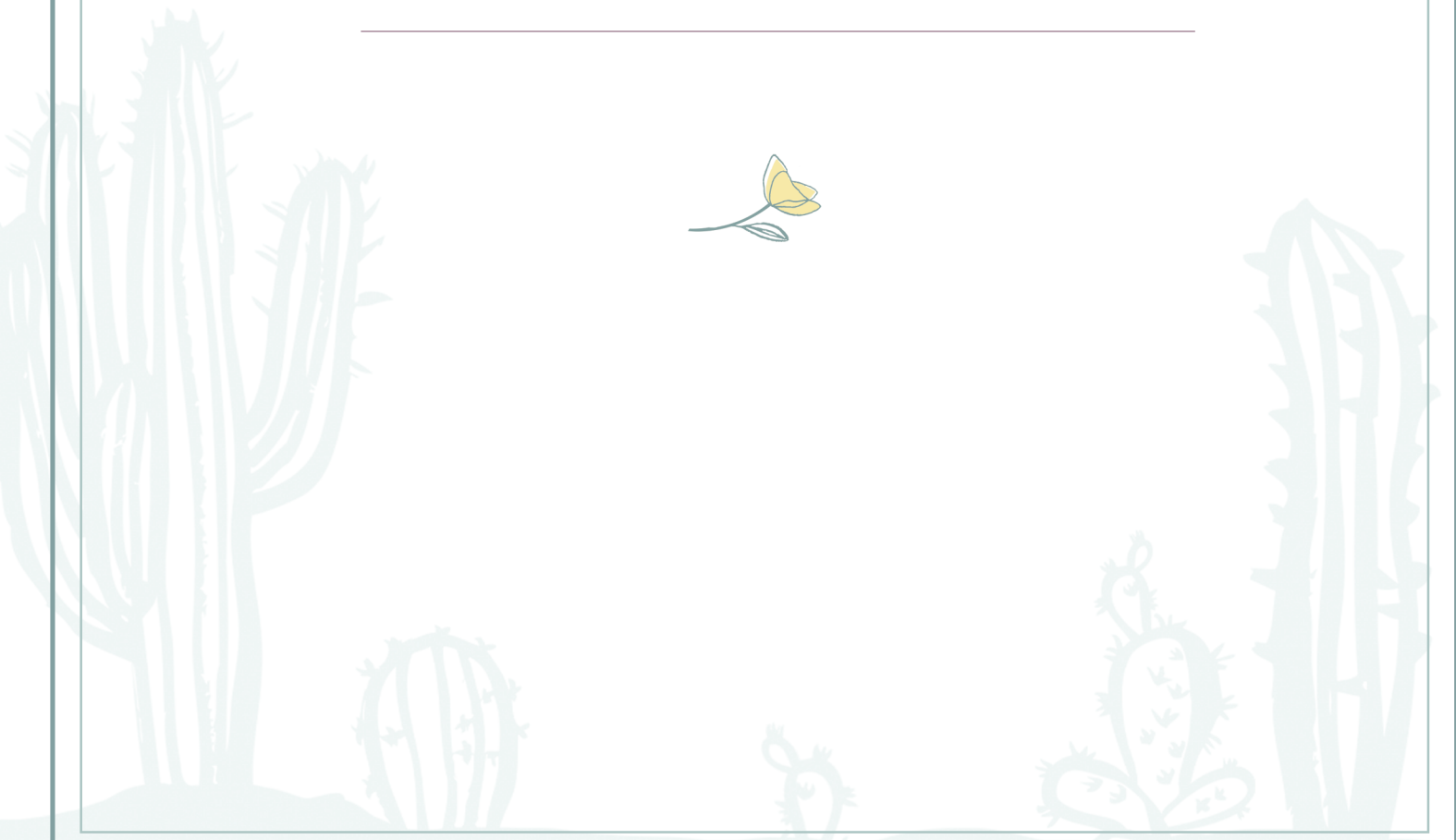




30 BIBLE VERSES THAT BRING FRESH AWARENESS OF GOD'S FAVOR TOWARD YOU
